Re: Non-Binding Letter of Intent to Partner on the Implementation of an Early Detection Cerebral Palsy Program

Dear Rachel,

This letter ("Letter of Intent") is intended to summarize the interest of the Fundación Obligado ("Fundación") to partner together with the Cerebral Palsy Foundation ("CPF") in the implementation of CPF's early detection cerebral palsy program in the Republic of Argentina ("Program").

The Program has proven to lower the age of cerebral palsy diagnosis from approximately two-years of age to 9.5 months. Earlier diagnosis of cerebral palsy is critical as it enables treatment to begin as early as possible leading to improved long-term outcomes. CPF utilizes a "train the trainer" model wherein CPF trains clinicians who are on the ground in the countries where they work, thereby creating a sustainable engagement model. The Program has had successful results both in the U.S. and around the globe, including most recently in Peru and Ireland. CPF's success working abroad and in different environments is a testament to the prowess of its proprietary training and programming, as well as the strong local relationships that CPF fosters.

Following a robust fundraising campaign, the Fundación is hopeful to bring the Program within the next five years to Argentina where it has an extensive network of providers with whom CPF could collaborate on advancing the implementation of the Program through the execution of its international guidelines. The Fundación has developed these relationships over the last sixty years of providing services in Argentina. Consequently, the purpose of this letter is to document:

- (1) The intention of the Fundación to collaborate with CPF in the development of the Program as the Fundación seeks financial resources and clinical support aimed at facilitating its implementation.
- (2) The intention of CPF to be a trusted partner of the Fundación for the establishment of the Program, so long as it is provided with sufficient financial, human, and clinical resources.

This Letter of Intent does not create any legal obligation for the Fundación or CPF. If CPF is in agreement with the foregoing and intends to collaborate with the Fundación, please sign, date, and return to us one copy of this Letter of Intent. We look forward to working with you!
